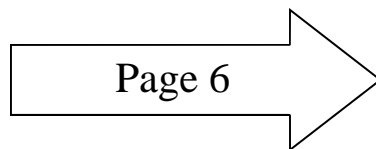
Directions to Silver City Canine Training Center.....

Good Sportsman Award

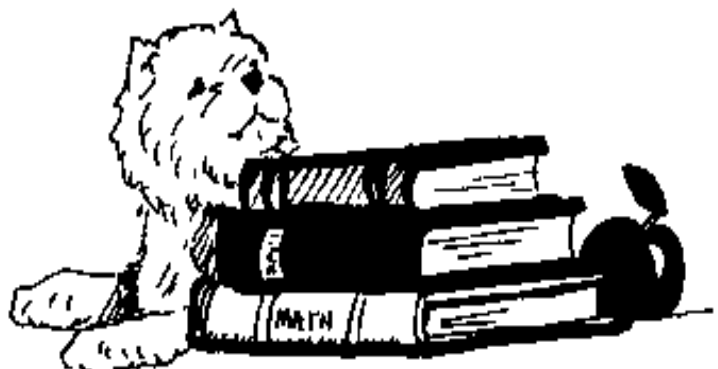
Mentor of the Year Award

In addition to the plaques awarded to members and their Westies who have earned titles throughout the calendar year, the Club also recognizes two members for outstanding service to other Club members and to the Club.

Good Sportsman Award: This award has become a tradition. *ALL Club members* are eligible. The Good Sportsman Award is generally given to a member who has exhibited exemplary service to the Club. These the “behind the scenes” people who are at a meeting ready to lend a hand, a member who volunteers to chair a meeting, takes the initiative to make guests feel welcome, gladly offers his or her time in whatever way to make a meeting/event a success. Do you know an individual in the Club who is deserving of this award?

Mentor of the Year Award: This award was made available to the Club in 198? through the generosity of John and Joyce McNabney in honor of Ruth Birmingham, one of our founding members and life long breeder. Ruth’s influence, input and hard work in forming our Club back in 1972 made our Club what it is today. It was through her caring and “mentoring” many Westie owners, especially the new owners, that this beautiful silver plate in its wooden case was called the “Mentor of the Year Award”. Is there a member of the Club who has been your mentor? Some one who is always “there” for you, to offer advice, lend a hand with your Westie or just *listen* to your concerns/problems regarding your beloved Westie? That is what being a “mentor” is all about.

To *nominate* a member for either of these awards, write a letter...minimum of 25 words, giving your reasons why this person is deserving of either award. Send your letter to Jennifer Fernandes, 27 Albee Rd., Millville, MA 01529 . Letters must be received by *January 26th, 2008*. At the February 2007 Board meeting, all nominating letters will be read and a vote taken for each award. At least *two nominations* for each award must be received or the award will be withheld. The names of the recipients will be kept secret until the Awards Banquet in March.

The owner or co-owner must be a member in good standing of the WHWTCNE. Only one plaque per dog is awarded. Subsequent awards for the same dog will receive a “dangle” that is attached below the plaque. Those Westies that achieved a title prior to the plaques being offered may purchase a plaque. All recipients of awards are encouraged to bring a picture of their Westie to be displayed with the award. Be sure the picture is labeled with your name and address, as well as your Westie’s name as it appears on the award.

Please Note: In order to assure that everyone receives their plaque at the dinner, as Kathleen receives your information, a return postcard will be sent to each participant verifying the dog’s name, owner, date and spelling. Therefore, please note—when you send your information to Kathleen, if you do not receive a verifying postcard from her in a timely fashion, it will be up to YOU to contact Kathleen to inquire. Sometimes things do get lost in the mail so don’t be disappointed come awards time.

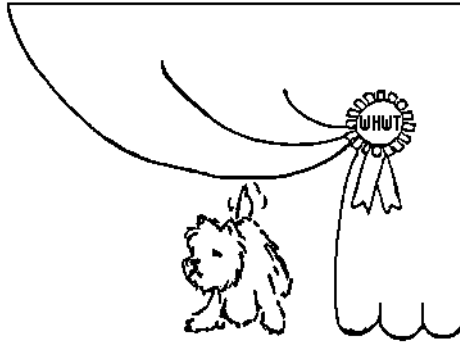
