I want to give you a heads up on a heartwarming rescue story.

Tony and I got a call the other day from a gentleman who was saddened over the death of a close friend/client. Apparently his elderly friend died unexpectedly at home alone. When the police found him they also found his faithful friend and companion sitting by his side - a Westie named Gordie that was Mr. Pence's constant and only companion for the last few years. This dog did everything with Mr. Pence and brought him great joy in his final years. I know this because we adopted him out from our rescue program to Mr. Pence and he would periodically update me on how happy Gordie was and how much he loved him. The police took Gordie to the Norwood Animal Shelter as Mr Pence had no family or caretakers - only Gordie. The gentleman that contacted us brought Gordie to us last Friday and slowly he has been coming out of his shell - he is

a quiet and loving dog - he is just now starting to wag his tail. The best news is that Susan (God Bless Susan) went through her applications to try and find the right match for Gordie and we really believe she did - his new "forever home" has been found. He has a new home and some new two and four legged friends. **WAY to GO GORDIE!!**

We should all take a moment to reflect on what may have happened to Gordie had our Rescue Program not been in place. Tragedies like Gordie's happen everyday and there is little we can do about it, however the happy ending is within our power. We were able to act swiftly and capably to get Gordie with people that can help him find a home that will understand the special needs of a Westie.

I want to thank all of the members who make our Breed Rescue possible. Our club fulfills a critical rescue need and your time, donations and support make us all proud to be part of club that is second

to none in its commitment to the care and welfare of the Breed we all love.
